OPERATION SCHOOL BELL®

Helps students reach their potential by fulfilling physical and emotional needs by providing new school clothing to students Kindergarten through eighth grade.



OPERATION LITERACY Promotes literacy among individuals of need in the Omaha community.

OPERATION TEEN PARENT Encourages teen parents to complete their high school education and awards post-secondary scholarships.

ACT / PSAT REVIEW SESSIONS Presents low-cost test-preparation seminars by professional instructors to prepare students for PSAT and ACT exams.

ASSAULT SURVIVOR KITS® Provides dignity to individuals during times of crisis by distributing kits containing hygiene products and new clothing to emergency rooms and crisis centers.

OPERATION BEAR HUG

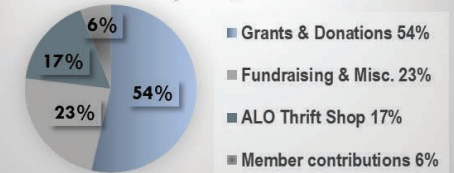
Provides comfort to children in crisis situations by providing emergency responders with teddy bears to distribute.

RESULTS

This year's ALO survey of school contacts reported the following outcomes from Operation School Bell:

- ◇ OSB was a positive experience: 99%
- ◇ saw positive change in student's classroom behavior: 81%
- ◇ saw positive change in student confidence: 92%
- ◇ saw positive change in school attendance: 36%
