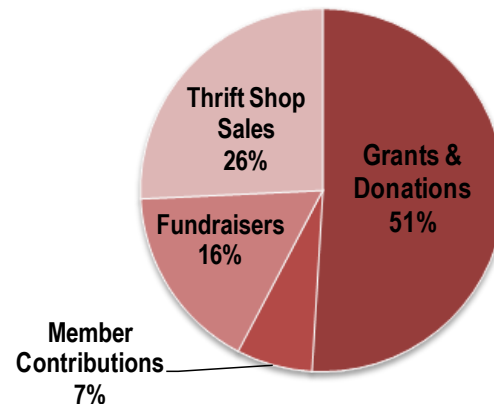
All proceeds after expenses fund local philanthropic programs. Assistance League volunteers served over 36,000 hours during fiscal 2016-17.

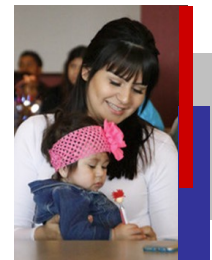
